Since the mouthpiece is an integral part of a wind controller, maintenance and cleaning is important to keep the instrument in good playing condition. The kit provides all the tools and parts necessary to properly maintain, clean and protect a WX mouthpiece. The included instruction sheet tells not only how to use the tools and parts supplied in the kit, but also provides critical instrument setup information on gain, zero and switch settings, which beginning players will find very helpful.



Professional players will find the kit useful to take along on gigs, keeping spare parts and tools on hand, right when they may be needed most. The carrying case has room to store spare mouthpieces and other accessories.
